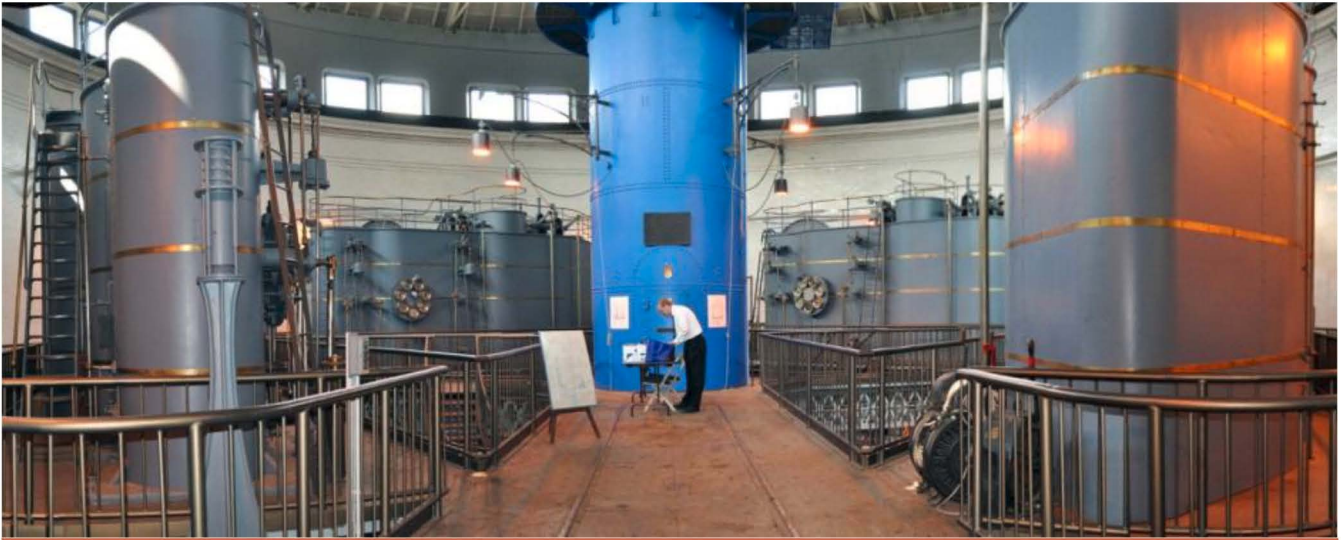

See these colossal engines up close and discover the architectural wonder of the building that houses them! ▪ Find out why Old River Station has been called "one of the world's best-kept secrets." ▪ Look inside the great pump chamber that moved a staggering 30,000,000 gallons of water every day for 57 years! ▪ This is not a disability-friendly facility, but it is possible to have a wheelchair (not supplied) on the main engine room floor with limited mobility.

Tours for individuals or small groups are available *as needed*; typically, they occur once a month on Saturday morning between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and noon. Photographers are welcome!

Construction of the seven-story circular pump house began in 1898, and the gigantic engines were set in motion in 1906. Your tour will take you from near the top of the facility all the way to the pump pit floor, five feet under the Ohio River!
